EXAM DATES, TIME AND VENUE

- Exams Commence on FRIDAY 4nd June (Subject to change due to COVID-19)
- Exams will be held in the HALL
- Students MUST be at school at 8:30am for
 8:40am exam commencement
- Exam schedule will be posted on compass and STUDENT HUB
- Please check the Parents tab on the website for Exam schedule which will be updated soon

STUDENT MUST

- Attend in full CORRECT school uniform must be worn
- Be at school no later than 8:30 sharp
- Go home after exams unless arrangements have been made with Coordinator
- Enter exam room in a quite and orderly manner
- Attend ALL exams unless unable to attend due to a medical reason- and therefore medical certificate MUST be presented to Coordinator
- Use ink pens on exam papers

Permitted items

- □ pencil cases, however you are to take what you need from your pencil
- □ Calculators are only permitted in the maths and physics exam ONLY.
- □ Water bottles, however MUST be in clear bottle. Branding wrapper must be removed

STUDENT MUST NOT

- Bring any Food items into exam room
- Touch exam paper until instructed
- Use pencil on exam papers, save maths and physics
- Use white-out
- Leave exam room until ALL exam papers have been collected.
- Go to bathroom unsupervised

NOT Permitted items

- ☐ Smart watches or phones
- □ Study notes
- □ Water bottles, however MUST be in clear bottle. Branding wrapper must be removed

SENIOR EXAM PROCEDURES

- Students will enter the exam venue as instructed and remain seated quietly.
- Instructions will be given to commence reading exam paper. Students are give 5 minutes reading time. Writing is not permitted during this period
- Timer is displayed on board for time management
- Once timer sounds for conclusion of 90 minutes.
 Exam supervisors are collected papers
- Students are not permitted to speak during exam collection
- Exam supervisors will instruct students to exit venue

STUDENT CONDUCT DURING EXAMS

- Students are not permitted to assist another student, or allow another student to copy, or accept assistance from another student. Cheating is a serious breach of policy.
- Students behaving in a manner that causes annoyance or interference to other students may be removed from the examination room.
- Students must stop writing when the signal to do so is given.

BREACH OF EXAM RULES

The Head of Senior School may impose any of the following penalties:

- Cancel the student's examination mark for the section of the examination for which the breach of rules has occurred.
- Cancel the student's examination and therefore the student's entire examination grade OR withhold marks indefinitely.
- In addition to the above penalties, the Head of Senior School retains the discretion to suspend the student from the Academy.
